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Hi Joby,

Thank you for asking me to act as a referee of the manuscript mentioned here. I had a quick reading of the paper and my impression is that it is very operational. It is merely an explanation how meter accuracy was measured. Little reference is given to explaining the context of why these calculations are made and what is the meaning of the outcome. E.g. no relation is given of meter inaccuracies to leakage or unknown consumption. Also no reference is made towards annual billing. The method explains that unreliable data recordings are filtered and corrected, but how this correction is

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done remains unclear. > Before putting time in reading the paper more carefully, I would like to rise the question if it should be more logical publishing this paper in a professional journal than in a scientific one?
